

Providence University Regulations on Graduation Criteria Review

Amended at the Academic Affairs Meeting on October 8, 2014

- Article 1 The Providence University Regulations on Graduation Criteria Review is established in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of the Ministry of Education and the practice of the University.
- Article 2 The graduation criteria include the total credits needed for graduation, Minor, Double Major, Credit-based Programs and other conditions stipulated by the respective departments.
- Article 3 The review of graduation criteria should be based on the standards set for the academic year of entry.
When there are amendments or adjustments to the graduation criteria mentioned in the preceding paragraph, the said criteria should be reviewed in accordance with the amendment or adjustment rules of the pertinent department.
- Article 4 Subject to satisfying the graduation criteria of the department of Major, the students who declare a Minor, Double Major, or Credit-based Programs shall meet the minimum required credits stipulated by the respective departments (colleges) to earn the said status with a certificate awarded.
- Article 5 The graduation criteria including the total credits earned from the department of Major, Minor, Double Major, and the English Proficiency Certificate shall be reviewed by the Div. of Registration and Curriculum.
- Article 6 The graduation criteria and the qualification of Credit-based Programs shall be reviewed by the perspective departments (colleges).
- Article 7 With regard to the students who may graduate in the current semester, each department (college) and the Div. of Registration and Curriculum shall complete the review, in a timely manner, on the total credits earned for graduation, other graduation criteria, and the qualification for Minor, Double Major, and Credit-based Programs after the results of their semester (including winter and summer sessions) studies are announced.
- Article 8 The supporting materials related to the graduation criteria shall be maintained by the respective departments (colleges) prior to the review.
- Article 9 For the examinations held by the respective departments, Foreign Language Center, or the approved intra-University units, the competent authority responsible for administering the examinations shall be responsible for reviewing and importing the passing list for the reference of the respective departments (colleges) in reviewing graduation criteria.
- Article 10 Any matters not provided herein shall be subject to the related regulations.
- Article 11 The Regulations are enforced upon the approval of the Academic Affairs Meeting; the same procedure applies to the amendments.
