Title: Providence University Regulations on the Establishment of College Feature Programs

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Regulations on the Establishment of College Feature Programs

Adopted at the Academic Affairs Meeting on April 16, 1997

- Article 1 The colleges of the University may establish feature programs based on the existing curriculum or, at their discretion, by offering additional courses in the attending departments.
- Article 2 The establishment of the feature programs (hereinafter referred to as the “**Programs**”) are subject to these regulations.
- Article 3 In principle, the courses offered in the Programs are based on the existing courses of the attending departments of the college for a minimum of 15 credits.
- Article 4 In principle, the students declaring the Program shall be studying with the regular classes. Where the number of enrolled students per class reaches the standard for a class split, an additional class may be offered.
- Article 5 The maximum number of additional hours for the Program per college is 20 hours per academic year
- Article 6 The maximum years of study for this Program is subject to the *University Academic Regulations*.
- Article 7 The participating colleges may establish the respective criteria of study in accordance with the Regulations and the needs of the respective Programs.
- Article 8 Upon the approval of the attending college, a certificate of program completion shall be issued to the students who have successfully completed the program required credits.
- Article 9 These Regulations shall enter into force upon the approval of the Academic Affairs Meeting; the same procedure applies to the amendments.
