Subject: All courses in 2022-23AY Summer Sessions Term 1; faculty class schedule

Descriptions:

- 1. The period of 2022-23AY Summer Sessions Term 1: June 19 July 28, 2023 (5-week classes for all subjects).
 - 1) Monday, June 19 Thursday, June 29: In-person classes.
 - 2) Monday, July 3 Friday, July 7: (Teams) Online instructions (campus-wide power outage due to high-voltage power conversion project).
 - 3) Monday, July 17 Friday, July 28: In-person classes.
- 2. Class suspension: Thursday, June 22 (Dragon Boat Festival); Fridays, June 23 and June 30 (bridge holidays). The campus is closed Monday, July 10 Friday, July 14.
- 3. The Teams start-up and student enrollment lists will be completed before the classes start. The teachers do not need to make additional versions. After entering the course, please click "Start" so that students can see the course. For the instructions of Teams, please go to "Assured Teaching and Learning" of Teaching Development Center.
- 4. During power outage (June 30-July 16): Teams will remain normal operation; for other information systems, please see the <u>bulletin of OITS</u>. Only Teams teaching is available Monday, July 3 to Friday, July 7. Please make sure to complete the system testing with your classes before the power outage. During the outage, please be sure to keep track of the students' learning and keep records of the online teaching for future external inspection.
- 5. For the respective faculty's Summer Course Schedule, please log on to e-Campus→ Systems→ Academics→ Faculty Class Schedule. Please refer to Attachment 1 for detail instructions.
- 6. For Students Roll Call List, please make the printout online after **June 19**. To operate: Log on to e-Campus → Academics → Roll Call List.
- 7. Please be sure to take the roll call and check against the list. If the students in your class are not consistent with the list, please fill in the errata form (next to the roll call list) and return it to the Div. of R&C before **July 17**.
- 8. Please use the "Course Roll Call System" of e-Campus to conduct online roll-calling. Each course should roll-call at least twice per week for verification. The instructions are as Attachment 2.
- 9.Please follow the 5-week teaching schedule. Do not shorten the course or end it early to maintain teaching quality and learning effectiveness.
- 10. In Summer Session, the Midterm Exam is scheduled to be conducted in Week 3, and Final Exam will be held in the last 2 sessions of Week 5. Please make sure students are notified of the exam schedules. The in-class exams, Midterm, and Final Exams are conducted in the forms of online testing, turning in reports, or any other non-physical present assessments. Please make sure this is clearly announced to the students in advance and beware of the fairness of evaluation.
- 11. The PU Academic Regulations has deleted the provisions for barring students from taking exams. Students' absence should be reflected in their final score of the course.
- 12. Please make use of the university e-learning platform to upload the handouts and teaching materials for students' reading or downloading.
 - 1) WOW Class: Log into e-Campus Service Multiple Learning Wow Class for operation manual, please follow the "? mark" on the upper right hand corner of the homepage.
 - 2)e-learning: Log into e-Campus Service All e-Campus Service Academic Affairs e-learning upload and discussion e-learning system (please refer to the instructions for teaching material upload on the webpage.)

- 13. Please refer to the relevant regulations on Intellectual Property Rights for teaching material and handouts. Please also advise students it is illegal to make photocopies or reproduction of others' publications. For the scope and information on using others' publication, please refer to PU Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs).
- 14. Teachers' leave taking, class rescheduling, and make-up classes, as well as students' leaving taking, are subject to the relevant regulations of the University.
- 15. Summer office hours and contacts:
