- A. Students of Initial Entrance in 2023/24 applying for a Minor, Double Major, and Credit-Based
 - 1. Service Hours: 09:00-24:00, September 4-8, 2023
 - 2. Application: Online application only. Please refer to the following steps: Application Steps: PU homepage → key in your account name and password, select e-Campus → select "Minor, Double Major Application" or "Credit-Based Programs Application". New applicants should select 2023/24 1st semester as the study term. Credit-Based Programs are limited to applications from undergraduate students.
 - 3. Please go to the "e-Campus" and select "e-portfolio: to enquire the results of your application. If there is any error/missing of the information, please apply for correction at the Div. of R&C by September 13 (Wednesday).
 - 4. Continuing students and students in suspension of study are excluded from application this time.
 - 5. Students can only take a double major of the same grade; or take a minor at the same grade or one grade lower. It's not allowed to take a Minor and a Double Major from the same Department (Division) simultaneously.
 - 6. Notes:
 - (1) According to the regulations, a new applicant must register for at least ONE course in the Minor or Double Major curriculum in the initial semester (2023/24 1st semester) of application. Failed to comply will lead to disqualification for studying a Minor or Double Major.
